- New CA Workplace Lactation Laws



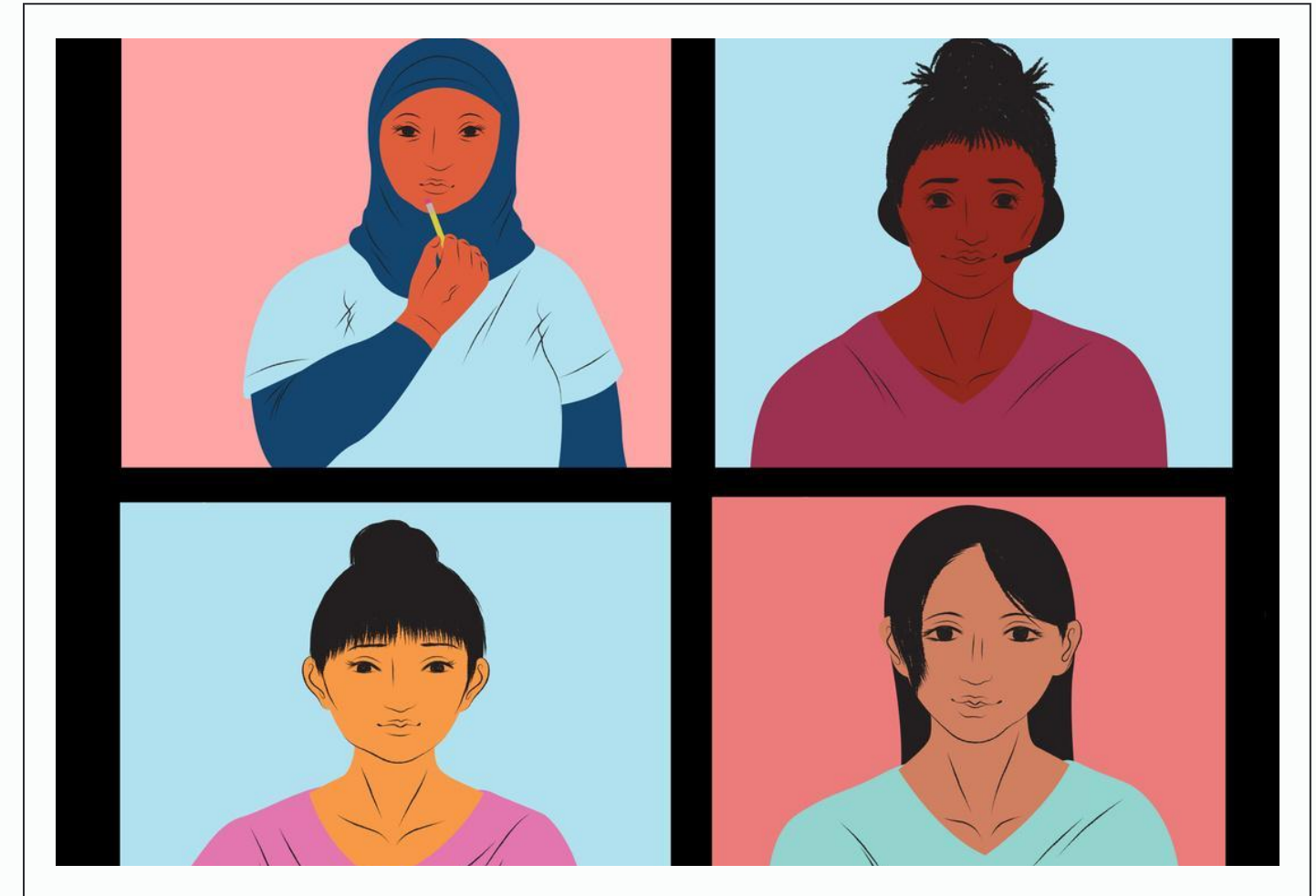
VIRTUAL General CONTINUING Education Sessions

Network with other Black professionals in the lactation field and those interested in supporting families with their infant feeding choices.

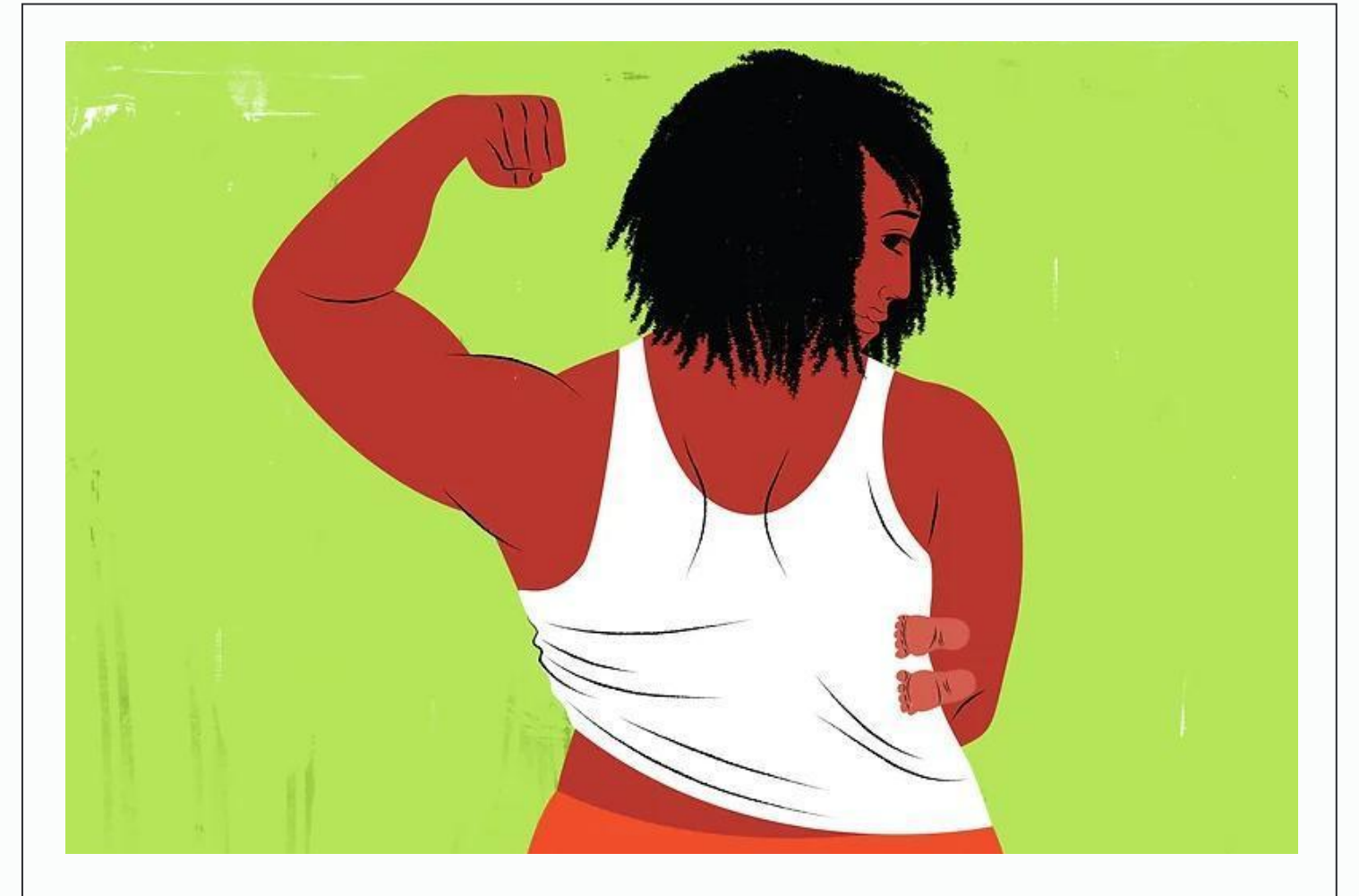

Our Quarterly Hospital Collaborative is a platform for those working in hospitals and community-based organizations to come together to learn, problem solve, plan and develop policy as we continue the race to be ready for the new birthing hospital requirements beginning January 1st, 2025.

The 2013, Senate Bill 402, De Leon, Health and Safety Code 123367 requires all hospitals with birthing units (16 in SB Co) to adopt, by January 1, 2025, The Ten Steps to Successful Breastfeeding, or the California Model Hospital Policy Recommendations, or the like.

2024 Courses:
