  - 10 sessions for pregnant women, followed by
  - o 10 sessions for new moms
- Case Management
- Individual Client Plans / Life Plans to help you plan your future
- Public Health Nurse and Social Worker
- Health and family support referrals
- Healthy refreshments
- Transportation assistance to and from group sessions
- Resources
